Growing older can be frightening with each year bringing change...to our bodies...to our minds...to our families and friends...to our finances...to society.

For more than 55 years, Presbyterian Homes of Georgia has cared for and served senior adults in four retirement communities in Georgia. As a Christian ministry, the Homes care for over 1,000 residents in all their varied circumstances—providing for them a life-long home.

The *Caring Hands Fund* is the heart of the ministry of Presbyterian Homes of Georgia. It exists to provide services to Health Services Center residents whose personal financial resources have been depleted. In the fifty years of this Presbyterian ministry, no resident has ever been asked to leave because they have outlived their financial resources.
